Post-Graduate Seminar 2 With Tanya Desfontaines

In this post-graduate seminar, we will explore in greater depth the emergence of embryological forces in session work with an orientation to the primal midline and local bioelectric ordering field. Trauma work continues with the Orienting response, working with the cervical spine and inhalation stillpoint processes to augment the expression of potency through the fluid midline.
